Million Worker March Youth and Student Demands:

We Demand:

**** An end to police brutality, racial profiling, and curfews. Stop round-ups and INS raids.

**** A living wage for all.

**** Universal free healthcare for all. Youth, particularly youth of color are a disproportionate 41% of the 44 million uninsured.

**** Money to stop HIV/AIDS. Half of all new infections in the U.S. occur in people under 25 years old.

**** Free college education and job training.

**** Money for books, not for metal detectors and police in our schools. Repeal the No Child Left Behind Act.

**** More teachers, no overcrowded classrooms, repair old schools and build new ones.

**** An end to the so-called U.S. "Drug War," and an end to attacks on the poor. End the Prison Industrial Complex. Money for jobs not jails.

**** Free Leonard Peltier, Mumia Abu Jamal, the Cuban Five, and all political prisoners.

**** Repeal the Patriot Act.

**** Affordable housing and an end to homelessness. 18 to 24 year-olds are the fastest growing sector of the homeless.

**** Stop the corporate poisoning of our environment. End environmental racism.

**** Amnesty for all undocumented workers.

**** No draft in 2005. No one should have to enlist to pay for school, to get benefits, or to find a good job. "Citizenship" should not carry the price tag of military service.

**** End the U.S. war on the world. End the Occupations of Iraq, Palestine, Haiti, and Afghanistan. Bring the troops home now.
