# **No neighborhood schools without schools in our neighborhood!**

The School department has been having the community meetings we demanded before making decisions on the school assignment process. At those meetings, parents from West Roxbury, and some City officials, have been demanding a return to neighborhood schools.

There are not enough schools in Dorchester, Roxbury and Mattapan for our kids to go to a neighborhood school!

*Don't get played:* Because our kids would still need to be bussed, the BPS would not save very much money by trying to return to neighborhood schools.

**Come out and tell the School Department “no neighborhood schools until we have quality schools in our neighborhoods!” Our kids deserve a quality education.**
